### ENTRIES CLOSE

Competitors that have their entry in by closing date go into the draw to win their entry free back. There will be a minimum of 8 prepaid entries for a class to exist, and a maximum of 40 per senior class.

### MX TIMING LTD – TRANSPONDERS

Lap-scoring will be by Electronic Transponder System supplied by MX Timing Ltd on both main track & mini track [www.mxt.co.nz](http://www.mxt.co.nz) \$10 may be deducted from entry fee if you are supplying your own transponders. This number must be provided with entry.

### MNZ LICENCE

Riders must hold a current MNZ Licence and must present that licence at sign in OR purchase a one event licence (minimum age 4yrs and over) for \$30 & club membership.

### RACE FORMAT

The CoC and Race Secretary reserve the right to change or alter classes if necessary. Some classes may have a split start. Depending on entries MX1 & MX125 / Jnr 125 & Jnr 250 / Vets 35-44 & 45+ yrs maybe split start. Some classes will fill up and day entries will not be accepted once our 40 gate limit is reached.

Any Mini's waiting to ride 65cc on the main track can enter the appropriate 85cc class, we will not be having an additional 65cc only class on the main track.

**Main Track** - Depending on entries received, and weather permitting – five races per class followed by **King of the Nuggets Feature Race**

**Mini Track** - Depending on entries received, and weather permitting – five races on Saturday and 4 races on Sunday.

### START

Competitors only allowed to groom the gate with hands or feet. No shovels or implements. Start will be clutch start behind backward falling gates.

### BIKE & BACK NUMBERS

Correct racing numbers are to be worn on the back of body armour or jersey & on bike as per rule 10.2b and 10.3b

**SAFETY GEAR:** All competitors must have the correct safety gear as per rule 8.1c including body armour – commercially available Motorcycle Body Protection (Armour) that must include back protection. Safety Helmets – as per rule 8.2 and helmet details must be shown in the appropriate section in the riders logbook. Boots - as per rule 8.3 **Cameras:** Cameras may be fitted to the motorcycle provided they are securely mounted. Camera mounts are subject to approval by the Machine Examiner. Helmet Cameras or other accessories are not permitted to be attached to the rider's Helmet as per rule 8.2n

**FLAGS:** Any Yellow Flag incident whether it be passing or jumping under the Yellow Flag will result in a two place relegation and a possible fine.

**MISSING PEGS:** Riders who miss pegs must return to the track as soon as it is safely possible without gaining an advantage, race position or damaging track markings. Should an advantage or gain in race position happen from the incident, or damage be done to the circuit markings while returning, the rider may be penalised as per rule 6.10a

### RIDERS REPRESENTATIVES

To be appointed at riders briefing.

### REFUNDS

Refunds of entry fees will be as per rule 5.5a

### TRACK/PIT RULES

**PIT BIKES** - Under **NO** circumstance will pit bikes be permitted at this event.

**PUSH BIKES** – Under **NO** circumstances will pushbikes be allow in the track paddock

### NO DOGS – NO EXCEPTIONS!

**Tear Offs:** **NO TEAR OFF'S** (tear offs are not permitted at this event). Any will be removed at the start line.

### ALCOHOL

The use of alcohol is not permitted as per rule 6.20

### INSPECTION

Random technical inspection as per rule 10.1

### FORCE MAJEURE CLAUSE

For reasons of Force Majeure, should a meeting or part of a meeting be cancelled, any entry fee refunds will only be made at the sole discretion of the organizers. The CoC and Race Secretary reserve the right to alter the meeting format / race duration as may be deemed necessary.
