MINIS: As per rule 15.9 - (A) Mini competitors shall compete in age groups. Subject to rule 15.9.(b), except for those turning 12, the age of a mini competitor on the first day of an event or series shall determine their age group for that event or series. (B) If a mini competitor's birthday falls during an event or series, (s)he may commence an event or series in the new age group. However, nothing in this rule shall allow a mini competitor to ride a capacity or type of mini machine under age.

JUNIORS: As per rule 15.19a: Junior competitors age shall be from and including the eighth birthday until the seventeenth birthday. 15.19b When a junior licence holder reaches 15 years they may remain as a junior until their 17th birthday, or they may return their junior licence for a senior licence. 15.19c (A) Subject to rule 15.19c (b), except for those turning 17, in age based competition, the age of a junior competitor on the first day of an event or series shall determine his/her age group for that event or series. (B) If a junior competitors birthday falls during an event or series (s)he may commence and complete that event or series in the next age group. However, nothing in this rule shall entitle a junior competitor to ride in the 125 classes under age 12. 15.19d Where a Juniors birthday falls during a consecutive multi day event the competitor may complete that event, in that class.

PROTEST COMMITTEE: MNZ Steward, Clerk of the Course and Rider Representative.

ENTRIES/REFUNDS: As per rule 5.5a - All entries must be accompanied by the correct fees. If the rider is unable to attend and notifies the Secretary of the meeting by phone or by written word 24 hours prior to event.

PAYMENT INFO: By Internet banking & accepted only if paid with validation number as reference and surname and initials as code. Payment must be received before entry will be processed. FORCE MAJEURE: For reasons of Force Majeure, should a meeting or part of a meeting be cancelled any entry fee refunds will be made at the sole discretion of the Organisers. The Organisers reserve the right to alter the meeting format as deemed necessary.

GATE ENTRY: Saturday and Sunday entry will be free to all competitors and mechanics before 9am. After 9am all people entering will pay gate entry fee.

RACE DURATION: SATURDAY:

Mini's – 3x races - as near as practically possible to 9 minutes plus 1 lap
 Juniors and Womens - 3 races for all classes
Trent Haywood Memorial Trophy: Highest Junior points scorer

SUNDAY:

MX1, MX2, 125cc 2 Stroke - 3x 15 minute race + 1 lap
 Vets, - 3x 12 minute races + 1 lap
 MX3 - 3x 12 minute races + 1 lap
Huka Honda Shoot Out – 40 riders - 3 laps; 20 riders - 2 laps; 10 riders - 1 lap; 6 riders - 1 lap; 3 riders - 1 lap; winner

HUKA HONDA SHOOT OUT - TOP 12 - MX1, MX2, 125cc 2 Stroke – points count towards your overall placing in class plus 5 x random prize draw of \$100 for Shoot out riders not in the prize money

NOISE TESTING: Noise Testing will randomly take place. Your bike must not exceed 96dBA, any bike exceeding 96dBA or above will be required to reduce their noise before starting.

FUEL TESTING: Approved fuel must be used. Testing may take place at any time throughout the series.

RANDOM TECHNICAL INSPECTIONS: As per MNZ Rule 10.1 random technical inspections may take place

BACK & BIKE NUMBERS: Correct racing numbers as issued by MNZ as on your MNZ Licence are to be worn on the back of body armour or jersey and on bikes as per rule 10.2b. Correct number board colours to be used as per rule 10.3b.

SAFETY GEAR: All competitors must have the correct safety gear and protective clothing as per rules 8.1 and 8.1a including Body Armour - Commercially available Motorcycle Body Protection (Armour) that must include back protection. Safety Helmets - as per rule 8.1i and Helmet details must be shown in the appropriate section in the rider's logbook. Boots - as per rule 8.2

RACE FORMAT: The organisers reserve the right to change or alter classes if necessary. Some classes may have a split start. Depending on entries received, and weather permitting – five races per class.

RIDERS BRIEFING: All riders are to be at briefing not just parents or pit crew as per rule 6.4. Saturday and Sunday. Riders Briefing will be at 9.00am and Practice starting at 9.15am

ALCOHOL: The use of alcohol is not permitted as per rule 6.20 until after racing is finished

STARTS: Clutch start behind backward falling gates. The start gates will be on dirt.

FLAGS: As per rule 6.18 Failure to observe flag instructions and signals renders riders liable to fine, exclusion, relegation, suspension or disqualification.
