Entry must be accompanied by Signed School Declaration (see separate attachment).

All riders are entered as individuals for their School.
Team points given to top 3 competitors from each School for riders entered in Expert Classes only.
If a class has less than 8 entries and the club decide to run the class, no team points available for these competitors.
Open to all students enrolled as abonafile (year 9 or above) full time student at the school of representation for 2021 and under 19 years of age as at 1/1/2021
Year 7 & 8 Support class – Riders not eligible for team points or year awards.

There will be a minimum of 8 prepaid entries for a class to exist, and a maximum of 40 riders per class. If more than 40 entries are received for any Expert Class then a combined Practice/Qualifying will be run with the top 40 fastest laptimes competing in the Expert Class and remainder of competitors will compete in the Novice class.

RACE FORMAT

The Organisers reserve the right to change or alter classes if necessary. Some classes may be split start or be combined depending on entry numbers received at close of entries (2nd July 2021). Weather/Time allowing – Practice & 3 rounds of racing

START

Will be a clutch start behind backward falling gates.

BIKE & BACK NUMBERS

All bikes must have front/side numbers or letters (No exceptions)

MNZ LICENCE

All riders must hold a current MNZ Licence & Club Membership, OR apply for a Complimentary One Event Licence - (includes Club membership for this event - request on entry form)
One Event Licence (Complimentary provided by MNZ)
In the absence of holding a MNZ Licence, competitors may apply for a One Event Licence. All riders must adhere to all rules as per the Manual of Motorcycle Sport (see www.mnz.co.nz) & the supplementary regulations:
Not limited too but including:
Competitor has no medical condition that prevents them from safely participating in this event & has not suffered from concussion or had a head injury in the last three weeks.
Their motorcycle is in a safe operating condition and type suited to this event, (all side stands must be removed).
One Event Licences must be completed in full at sign-in before **participating** in any part of the event and must be signed by the competitor and if under 18 years of age counter signed by a Parent or Guardian.

MINIMUM SAFETY STANDARDS MUST BE ADHERED TO. Helmet (approved standard), goggles, body armour with back protection, gloves, long pants & boots, as per 8.1 & 8.1c & helmets as rule 8i.2a & 8.2n. Bikes must comply with rule 10.

Note: Helmet Camera's are not permitted.
