- I shall abide by any decision directed at me by the Steward of the Meeting. And understand that any competitor making a false declaration may be disqualified from the event.
- I have read the Supplementary Regulations for this Competition and agree to be bound by them and the Manual of Motorcycle Sport, the MNZ Constitution, and the MNZ Code of Conduct.
- I am aware that the sport of Motorcycle Competition might a) cause me injury; serious or otherwise b) damage my property.
- I wish to take part in the SX4 despite the above risks.
- Neither I, or anyone associated or connected with me will make any claim against you or your officers, employees or agents in respect of: a) any injury suffered by me; or b) any damage to any of my property regardless of how the injury or damage occurs.
- I will indemnify you against all claims, damages or losses (including costs) which you incur as the direct or indirect result of any injury to me or damage to my property.
- I am physically fit and there is no health or other reason why I should not participate in the sport of Motorcycle Competition.
- I am aware that this disclaimer will not affect any legal obligations you have to me which you cannot contract out of under NZ Law.
- I agree that in this disclaimer "my property" includes any property owned by me or in my possession or under my control.
- I agree that this disclaimer will be binding on my family, my heirs, my legal assigns and my administrators and executors.
- I accept that stripping and re-assembly for Technical Checks are at my cost.

FORCE MAJEURE:

For reasons of Force Majeure, should a meeting or part of a meeting be cancelled any entry fee refunds will be made at the sole discretion of the Organisers. The Organisers reserve the right to alter the meeting format as deemed necessary.

RACE DURATION:

Advised on race day at riders briefing.

BACK & BIKE NUMBERS:

Correct racing numbers as issued by MNZ as on your MNZ Licence are to be worn on the back of body armour or jersey and on bikes as per rule **10.2b**. Correct number board colours to be used as per rule **10.3b**.

SAFETY GEAR:

All competitors must have the correct safety gear and protective clothing as per rules **8.1** and **8.1a** including Body Armour - Commercially available Motorcycle Body Protection (Armour) that must include back protection. Safety Helmets - as per rule **8.1i** and Helmet details must be shown in the appropriate section in the rider's logbook. Boots - as per rule **8.2**

RACE FORMAT:

The organisers reserve the right to change or alter classes if necessary. Some classes may have a split start. Depending

on entries received, and weather permitting – five races per class.

RIDERS BRIEFING:

All riders are to be at briefing not just parents or pit crew as per rule **6.4.**, riders Briefing will be at 7.45am and Practice starting at 8.00am sharp

ALCOHOL:

The use of alcohol is not permitted as per rule **6.20** until after racing is finished

STARTS:

12 rider gate start, 10sec, 5 sec board will displayed and then riders go starters control

FLAGS:

As per rule **6.18** Failure to observe flag instructions and signals renders riders liable to fine, exclusion, relegation, suspension or disqualification.

PRIZE GIVING:

To be held at the clubrooms at the conclusion of racing day.

NO DOGS: Dogs are not permitted at this venue and will be asked to leave

GA TICKETS: Every entry form includes 1 x GA ticket

PITS: Gates will be open from 6:45am for parking in what is known as the old "supercross" pits. Your vehicle/trailer must be removed at the completion of Amateur racing and parked in the GA parking if you are staying to watch the SX4 twilight event to make room for the competitors arriving for the afternoon.
